CATALOG STATEMENT: This minor provides an introduction to the management and maintenance of turfgrasses used for aesthetics (residential and commercial lawns, parks, institutional grounds), recreation (golf courses, athletic and sports fields), and functional purposes (sod farms, highway medians, inland and coastal erosion control sites, conservation). This minor will also assist those interested in sales, marketing, or any other business aspects of turf or ornamental industries. Not open to students declaring the Turfgrass Science concentration in the Sustainable Plant and Soil Systems major.
