<u>CATALOG STATEMENT</u>: This minor provides an introduction to the production, maintenance, and use of plants to enhance human environments. Not open to students declaring the Environmental Horticulture concentration in the Plant Science major.

REQUIREMENTS: All students are required to complete a minimum of 15 credits as outlined below.

- Students must earn a combined grade point average of 2.5 or higher for all courses listed above.
- Students must complete all requirements for a baccalaureate degree. Once the minor has been declared, it will appear on the student's transcript.

<u>DECLARATION PROCEDURE</u>: Students who wish to declare the minor prior to graduation must submit the <u>CAHNR MINOR DECLARATION FORM</u>, available on the Forms page of the CAHNR Undergraduate Academic Programs website.

<u>APPROVAL</u>: A plan of study for the minor signed by the department or program head, director, or faculty designee must be submitted to the Office of the Registrar via the Student Administration System during the first four weeks of the semester in which the student expects to graduate.
