<u>CATALOG STATEMENT</u>: This minor provides an in-depth exploration of food systems through performing an intensive summer work experience and fall internship (six credits) and reflecting on the practice of working in a sustainable community food system. Farm experience through working at the Spring Valley student Farm (or another approved farm or community garden) is required and residence at the far for at least a summer is encouraged. Not open to students declaring the Sustainable Agriculture concentration in the Plant Science major.
